Margaret's career in art includes an MA in Art from California State University, Fullerton, over 25 years of teaching drawing and painting courses for Los Rios Community College District, designing artwork for corporations that include Sheraton, Hyatt and Exxon as well as drawing over one thousand portraits a month at Disneyland. Margaret has created instructional videos to "teach the world to draw" in a way that is fun, funny and without judgement on her YouTube channel: Draw Here Now.

Margaret Welty was the creator and host of the educational television series Art, Creativity, & You, broadcast by Sacramento Educational Cable Consortium TV for eight years. As an art professor at Folsom Lake College for 25+ years, she has taught thousands of artistically blocked adults and young people to draw, and to draw well. Margaret holds a BA and MA in studio art from California State Fullerton, with post graduate work in painting with Oliver Jackson at CSUS. She has created site-specific commissioned art for Exxon, Raley's Corporate Headquarters, Sheraton, Hyatt, San Bernardino County and many others.

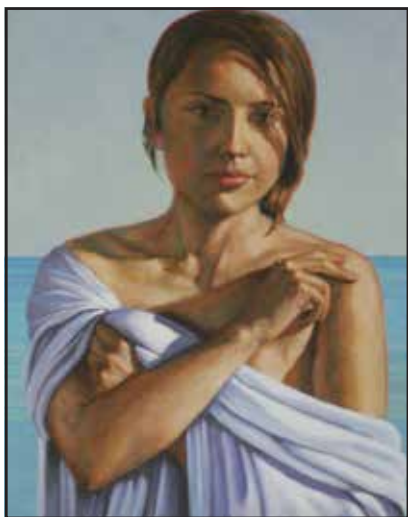
